

LA PLATA FOOD BUSINESS FINDINGS

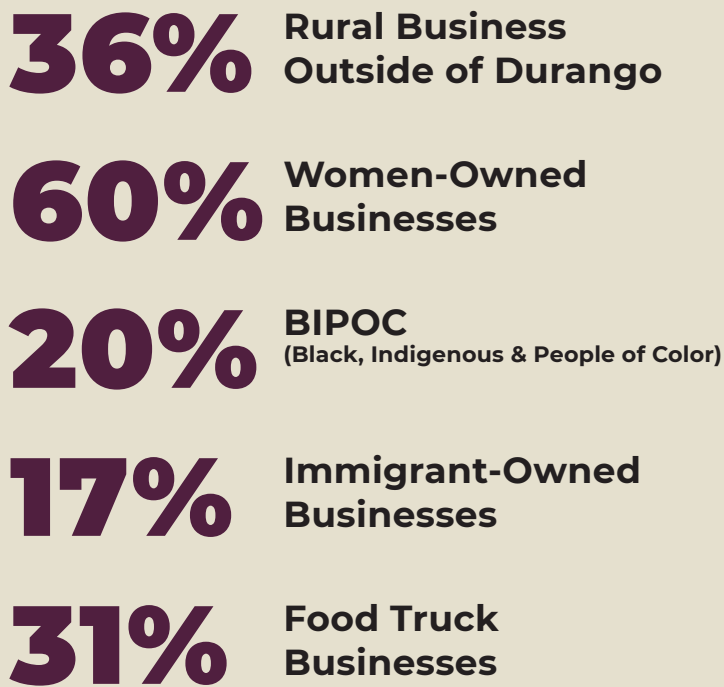


Income is one of the greatest barriers to food security so LPFEC is supporting food business owners to help them gain economic security to feed their families and our community.

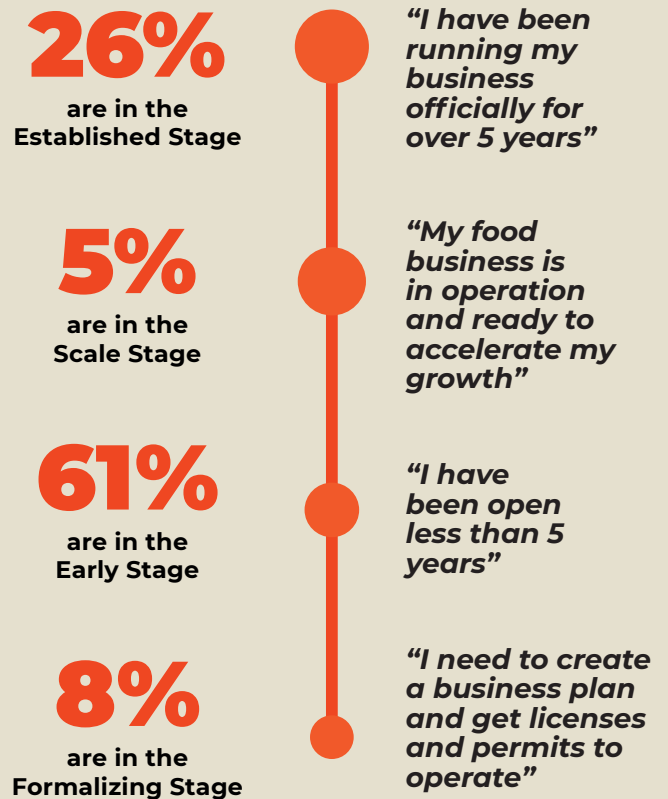
